

## Night work on Swansea Bridge, Pacific Highway, Swansea, from Monday 23 October

### The NSW Government is funding biannual essential maintenance work to ensure the safe and reliable operation of the bridge.

Roads and Maritime Services is carrying out the work which includes inspecting and testing the electrical, mechanical and hydraulic components and the emergency system of the bridge. Work will also be carried out to refurbish some of the hydraulic equipment and trial deck resurfacing materials.

We will be working between **7pm** and **5am** from **Monday** to **Thursday** and expect to complete the work in **four nights**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

#### How will the work affect you?

There may be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning machinery off when not in use.

#### Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

One bridge will remain open at all times while the maintenance work is being carried out, which will operate with one lane in each direction. **The southbound bridge will be closed at night on Monday 23 October. The northbound bridge will be closed at night on Tuesday 24 October, Wednesday 25 October and Thursday 26 October.**

The bridge will not be open to marine traffic while the work is carried out.
